Used on the pantry floor



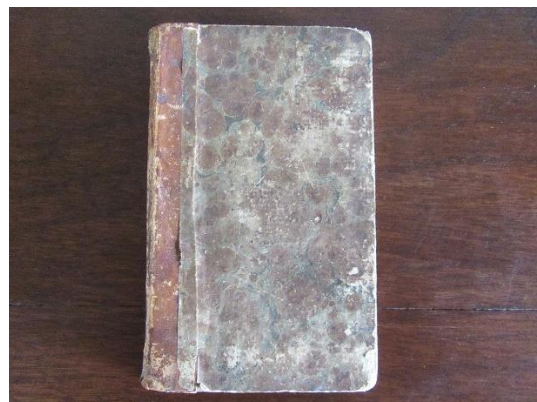
Woolen Shawl - \$35

Finished with a lead glaze!

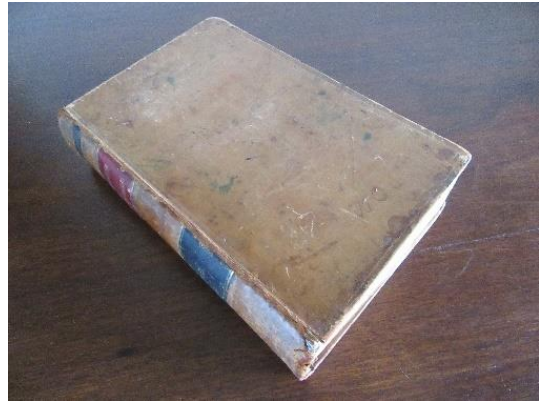


Arithmetic Book, 1836 - \$40

Used to store food for the long winter



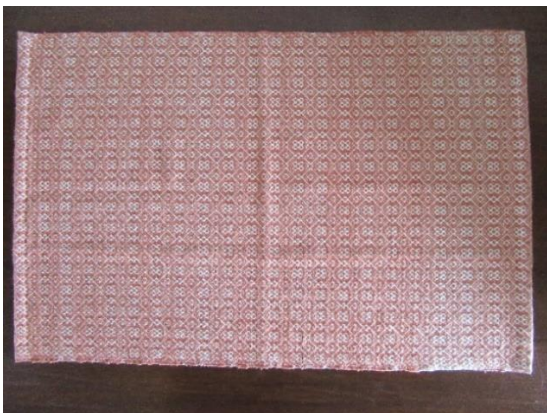
Revised Statutes of Wisc. 1849 - \$50

Made at Fennimore Farm Museum, NY



Handmade Broom-Corn Broom - \$50
Made in the Canterbury Shaker Village

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Wooden Neck Yoke - \$50
Used to carry two (heavy!) buckets of water



Hand-Forged Ash Shovel - \$75
An essential tool in hearth cooking



Conner Prairie Cotton Dress - \$75
Costume for our young volunteers



Conner Prairie Cotton Dress - \$75
Made for Conner Prairie Village in Indiana



Brass Apple Butter Kettle - \$75
Used to cook maple syrup or apple butter



Sturbridge Cotton Dress - \$100
Worn by young Elisabeth Clark

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Cast Iron Kettle - \$125
For indoor hearth or outdoor firepit cooking



1790 Iron Tea Kettle - \$200
One of the oldest Clark House artifacts



Clothes Washing Set-Up - \$200
One of our most popular hands-on activities



Hired Man's Shaving Mirror - \$300
Beautiful curly maple and mahogany



Lift-Top Library Desk - \$400
A nice cherry mid-19th century artifact



1850 Pine Dry Sink - \$1,300
Water was carried in for kitchen chores
